Big Idea—*The gospel is not the result of human invention or tradition, but it originated in God's heavenly wisdom and is rooted in historical events.*

Introduction: One Side of the Call

Accusations Against Paul

1. *Paul is a subordinate apostle preaching a derived gospel.*
2. *Paul is a fickle people pleaser.*

Paul's Defense: Not Man's Gospel

1. *Paul did not receive or learn the gospel from any man.*
2. *Paul's life radically changed after his conversion.*

Lessons from Paul's Defense

1. *The gospel has heavenly origins and historic roots.*
2. *Conversion is the inevitable result of God's election and calling, not man's efforts.*
3. *The nature of conversion demonstrates the nature of the gospel, that it is all of grace.*
4. *Conversion includes real change.*
