Big Idea: *Salvation is receiving God's promise by faith in Christ.*

Introduction: The Nature of a Promise

1. The substance of a God-made covenant is permanent

Key References— Luke 15:12; Matthew 7:11

2. The substance of God's covenant with Abraham and his offspring consisted of promises.

Key References— Genesis 12:2–3, 7; 15:4–5; 17:6–8; Galatians 3:8, 29

3. Because the law came after the promises, it did not change the substance of the covenant.

Key Reference—Habakkuk 2:4

4. Therefore, the promise has priority over the law, and the inheritance of salvation comes by promise and not law.

Key Reference—Leviticus 18:5

Conclusion: Receive the Promise by Faith
