**Introduction: Great Expectations**

**What Should I Expect of My Pastor?**

- 1. You should expect your pastor to exercise, not abdicate, his authority.*
- 2. You should expect your pastor to exemplify godliness.*
- 3. You should expect your pastor to be radically biblical.*
- 4. You should expect your pastor to be divinely called and equipped.*
- 5. You should expect your pastor to exhibit a whole-life commitment to his ministry.*
- 6. You should expect your pastor to steadily make progress, not achieve perfection.*
- 7. You should expect your pastor to closely watch over souls.*
- 8. You should expect your pastor to persevere.*
